## TSCHAIKOWSKY "ROMEO AND JULIET"

Tschaikowsky composed "Romeo and Juliet" in the autumn of 1869 and rewrote it in the summer of 1870. It was first published in 1871. Ten years later he revised and republished the score. It is the version 1881, that is universally used. The composition of the overture was suggested by Mily Balakirtw, to whom the work is dedicated.
