Dieter Weitz studied organ and harpsichord first of all at Karlsruhe Music College, and then at Trossingen Music College (in the class of Professor Helga Kirwald).

In 1986-1987 he spent a period of study with Ton Koopman in Amsterdam. Having acquired a music teacher's certificate, in 1986 he obtained a qualification as a performing organist, following by another as a harpsichordist in 1988.

In 1990 Mr Weitz successfully passed the concert examination for harpsichord. He completed his training by taking master classes with distinguished musicians like Bob van Asperen, Harald Vogel and L.F.Tagliavini. He has been a frequent performer on the radio. Since 1989 Dieter Weitz has held a teaching position as harpsichord répétiteur and coach at Trossingen Music College. He has also been working successfully with Maurice Steger for many years.
